Work Experience Requirement

Verification of three (3) years of work experience which can be a combination of work, education, and teaching experience. Refer to chart below:

Work Experience:

- 1,000 hours = 1 year of work experience
- Part time summer work is allowed, as well as volunteer work
- College projects are not allowed as work experience

Education can be used in place of 1 year of work experience:

- Bachelors or Masters degree in related field counts for 1 year of work experience

Teaching can be used in place of 1 year of work experience:

- 1 year of classroom teaching may be used for work experience

Various Combinations to Meet 3-Year Work Experience Requirement Work - Education - Teaching	
For those who have never taught <u>and do not have</u> a Bachelors or Masters degree in related field	3 years Work Experience
For those who have never taught but <u>do have</u> a Bachelors or Masters degree in related field	2 years Work Experience 1 year for Education degree
For teachers who have taught but <u>do not have</u> a Bachelors or Masters degree in related field	2 years Work Experience 1 year Teaching Experience
For teachers who have taught and <u>do have</u> a Bachelors or Masters degree in related field	1 year Work Experience 1 year for Education degree 1 year Teaching Experience

1 year of work experience must be recent within the past 5 years;
if not, 2 years of work experience is required in the past 10 years.

All work, education and/or teaching experience must be verifiable.
